Mr Izzard-Snape will be available during the parents evenings to answer any queries and Mrs Roper will be available to offer guidance or advice on Special Needs or Anti-Bullying issues, although these can also be discussed with your child's class teacher.

Dropping Children at School

Can we please remind parents not to park in the school car park or park/drop off directly outside the main gates when dropping off and collecting from out of school clubs as this blocks the gate for staff trying to enter/exit the site. Please can parents also not use the main car park gate to walk their children into school as this is very dangerous with cars using the gate regularly. **There are two pedestrian entrances which should be used at all times, and a zebra crossing directly outside the community entrance.**
