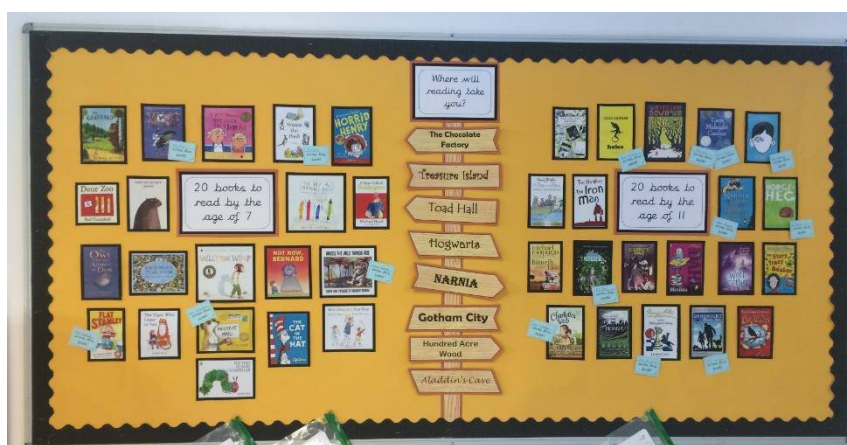


Mars House Mufti Day
