Penny Sweets

Reading You can read:

- Your School reading books and Library Book.
- Other Fiction books and non-fiction books.
- Ask your child questions:

- What did you like/dislike and why?
- What happened at the beginning/middle/end of the book?
- How do the characters feel? How do you know?



Number – can you do these from memory

- Count to and across to at least 100, forwards and backwards from any number. - Read and write numbers to 100.
- Count in 2's, 10's and then 5's to 100.
- Know 1 more and 1 less than a given number to 100
- Double numbers to 5. Halve even numbers to 10.



Phonics

- Learn the sounds and words in your child's phonics book
- Word build using the sounds
- Spell words using the sounds

Bigger Treats


Wonderful Writing (choose 1)

- 1) Write a report about Spring – What is Spring? When is Spring? What happens in Spring? What is the weather like in Spring? You could use these headings, draw pictures and write sentences.
- 2) Write a poem using rhyming words.

Remember to write sentences with capital letters and full stops. Use your neatest handwriting.

Magnificent Maths (choose 1)

- 1) Odd and even numbers – Can you sort numbers to 10, then 20, then 50, then 100?
- 2) Multiplication – e.g: $2 + 2 + 2 =$, $3 \times 5 =$, $10 + 10 + 10 + 10 =$ Use counting in 2's, 5's and 10's or pictures (draw groups) to solve.

Fantastic Forces (choose 1)

- 1) Life cycle of a plant- Can you draw and write about the life cycle of a sunflower.
- 2) Plants and trees – draw or use pictures of plants and trees then name and label.

Poster Perfect (choose 1)

Design a poster for any of these topics: draw pictures, label, add facts.

- 1) Aliens – can you draw aliens and then create your own nonsense names using split digraphs (a-e, i-e, o-e, u-e, e-e) or trigraphs (air, ear, ure, igh, oor, ore, are, ire)?
- 2) Plan of your garden – draw and label. What is growing in your garden?
- 3) The Royal family – can you make the Queen's family tree?

Amazing Arts and Crafts (choose 1)

- 1) Repeating patterns – can you create your own using 3 different shapes and colours? Can you use 4 different shapes and colours?
- 2) IT art - Can you create art using a paint package?

Your 2 or 3 Bigger Treats must be completed and in school by **Wednesday 24th May**. You can complete Bigger Treats on larger pieces of paper or using ICT if this is easier.
