Dear Parents/Carers

The 2.5 day residential experience we organise for our Year 4 students is such a tremendous success that we are organising one for next year. I feel it is an important experience for children to help them build their independence, communication, self esteem, motivation and team building skills.

Year 4 will be visiting the Everdon Activities Centre (near Daventry) from the afternoon of Wednesday 18th to Friday 20th April 2018. The curriculum will be tailored to the needs of the school and will be based around elements of Science, Geography, PSHE, PE and team work skills. This will be an opportunity for children to have some outdoor learning experiences to compliment our curriculum. The children will stay in dormitories at the Centre with school staff with the children at all times. Mrs Reith and Mrs Blakemore plus one other member of staff will be attending from Loatlands.

The cost per child will be £130. We are asking for an initial deposit of £45 (non-refundable) by Friday 3rd November. Virtual vouchers cannot be used to pay the deposit, however they can be used to pay the remaining balance. Payment can be made online through your child's scopay account which can be accessed via the school's website www.loatlandsprimary.net A further instalment of £45 will be due by 12th January 2018, with the final balance of £40 payable by 9th March 2018.

The costs will include equipment, meals, centre staff to run activities and travel costs to and from the centre (travel costs have been subsidised with a donation from PALS). The centre will even be able to offer sleeping bags, water proofs and wellies for those children who do not have these.
