Dear Parents

A residential visit has been arranged to Scarborough for Monday 25th June to Friday 29th June 2018. The trip is open to Year 6 pupils only.

Accommodation will be at the Stuart House Hotel (where we have stayed previously). This visit will encompass visits to Scarborough and Whitby to study aspects of history, geography and science. Miss Durling will be the lead staff member for the trip.

The cost of the trip is £235.00 per child. The cost includes travel, hotel rooms and various activities that the children will be undertaking through the week including trips to Scarborough Castle, Whitby Abbey, Eden Camp museum, boat trip on the Barque Endeavour, visit to Sea Life Centre, activities in Peasholm Park (including water rides) and train ride.

We are asking for an initial deposit of £50 (non-refundable) by Wednesday 31st January 2018. Virtual vouchers cannot be used to pay the deposit, however they can be used to pay the remaining balance. Payment can be made online through your child's scopay account which can be accessed via the school's website www.loatlandsprimary.net A further instalment of £50 will be due by 28th February, and further instalments of £45 will be due by 31st March, 30th April and 31st May. We expect all monies to be paid by 31st May 2018.

Please return the reply slip attached to ensure we have permission for all children to take part in the water activities that are planned.

May I also take this opportunity to emphasize that residential trips, though beneficial have to be rigorously managed. Consequently, response to discipline and good behaviour are pre-requisites to the trip so that staff can be certain pupils will respond in an appropriate manner at all times. The school reserves the right to exclude any pupils from the activity if their behaviour in school is such, that it could put themselves, other pupils, staff or public at risk or inconvenience.

I hope that you take this opportunity to support this exciting experience for Year 6.
