<p><b>Reading</b> You can read:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Your Scheme Reader or Library Book</li> <li>- Other Fiction books, short stories, poetry collections</li> <li>- magazines, comics, newspapers</li> <li>- Non-fiction books, information texts, recipe books</li> </ul> <p><i>Make sure that an adult signs your Reading Record every time you read so that you can claim your House Points. We will check Reading Records every <b>Monday</b>.</i></p>	<p><b>Wonderful Writing</b> (choose 1)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Imagine Jack climbed the beanstalk and found a completely different setting and characters at the top. What could these be? Describe them, using lots of exciting vocabulary and <i>expanded noun phrases</i>. E.g. Jack has an <i>exciting and scary adventure</i> in the land of the Jurassic Dinosaurs.</li> <li>2) Write a sentence using a conjunction E.g. Jack went up the beanstalk <i>because</i> he wanted an exciting adventure.</li> <li>3) <b>Challenge:</b> Write a sentence using <b>each</b> conjunction (and, but, so, because, if, when, that).</li> </ol>
<p><b>Practise your times tables.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Counting in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's.</li> <li>- Chanting times tables for 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's</li> <li>- Practice times tables out of order e.g. <math>4 \times 2 = 7 \times 2 =</math></li> </ul> <p><b>Challenge :</b> Practice all times tables out of order E.g. <math>6 \times 5 =</math> , <math>2 \times 2 =</math> , <math>4 \times 3 =</math> , <math>6 \times 10 =</math></p>	<p><b>Magnificent maths</b> (choose 1)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Measure items around your house in cm and m.</li> <li>2) Draw fractions of shapes. Can you shade in a half, a quarter or a third?</li> <li>3) Find fractions of amounts using a bar model.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Learn spellings</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Look, say, cover, write, check</li> <li>- Ask someone to test you</li> <li>- Is there a spelling rule that helps?</li> <li>- Identify the tricky part &amp; a way to remember it</li> </ul> <p><i>Don't forget spelling tests are every <b>Friday</b>. New spellings are given out on a <b>Friday</b>.</i></p>	<p><b>Super Science</b> (choose 1)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Create a fact file of your favourite dinosaur. E.g. What did it look like? Where did it live? What did it eat? How did it survive? Interesting facts.</li> <li>2) Write an information sheet about how to grow beans. Plant your own 'magic bean' and watch it grow!</li> </ol>
