Magnificent Maths (choose 1)

- 1) Can you draw a clock with all the numbers in all the correct places and write a list of the times that you do things, such as have dinner, got to bed etc.
- 2) Can you write the number bonds to 10 for example $0+10=10$, $1+9=10$, $2+8=10$ etc Can you use drawing to show us the number bonds eg, 1 yellow circle, 9 red.

Super Science (choose 1)

- 1) Can you keep a moon diary? How does the moon change over the month?
- 2) Go outside and play on a really cold day. What did you do? What did you wear? How did it feel?

Wonderful Writing (choose 1)

- 1) Can you find out about the different planets in our solar system and write a sentence about them.
- 2) Can you draw an astronaut and label what they might take to space with them.

Amazing Arts and Crafts (Choose 1)

- 1) Make us a rocket out of junk.
- 2) Can you create a space picture? Use any kind of media that you would like, paint, chalk, glitter etc.
- 3) Create your own imaginative space alien. Where do they come from? What's their name? What are they like? Could you build it out of playdough?
