Jewellery

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 **are not allowed** to wear jewellery or watches, this includes earrings. These should be removed before coming to school.

Children in Years 3 to 6 are only allowed to wear a watch and one pair of stud earrings. Earrings must be removed by the child for PE. If your child is unable to remove earrings themselves, they should be removed before they come to school.

Water Bottles

Please can all children bring a water bottle into school. We do not have access to a water fountains so water bottles are essential for hydration. (water only please)

Add that all up across our school's network of families and together we can all make a big difference!

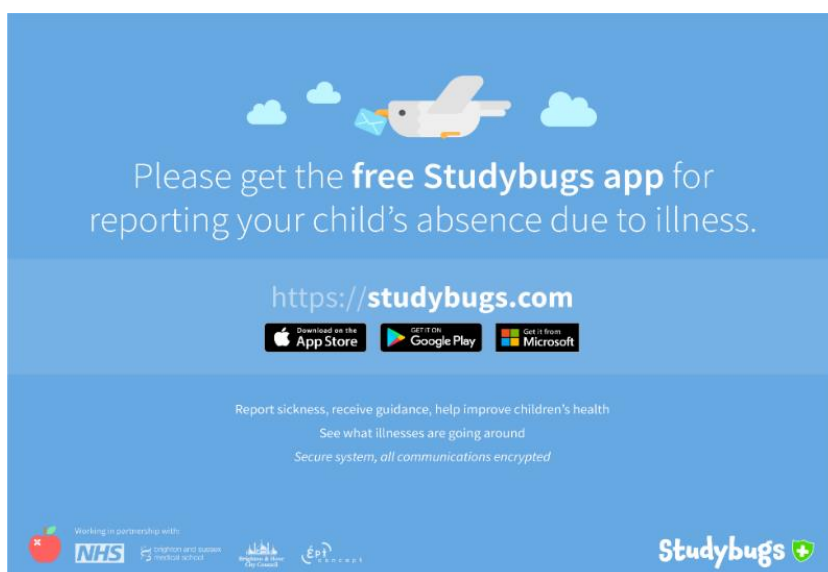
How to get involved

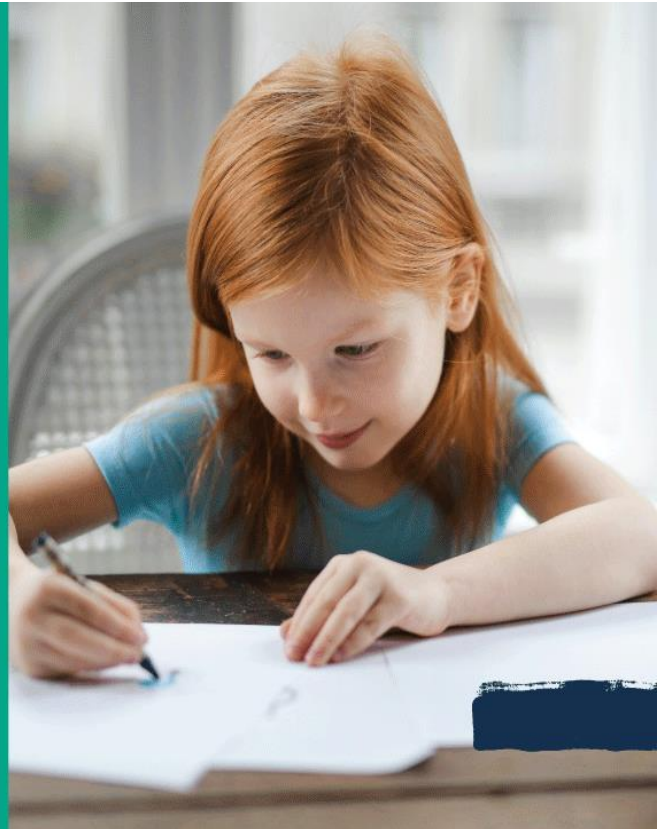
