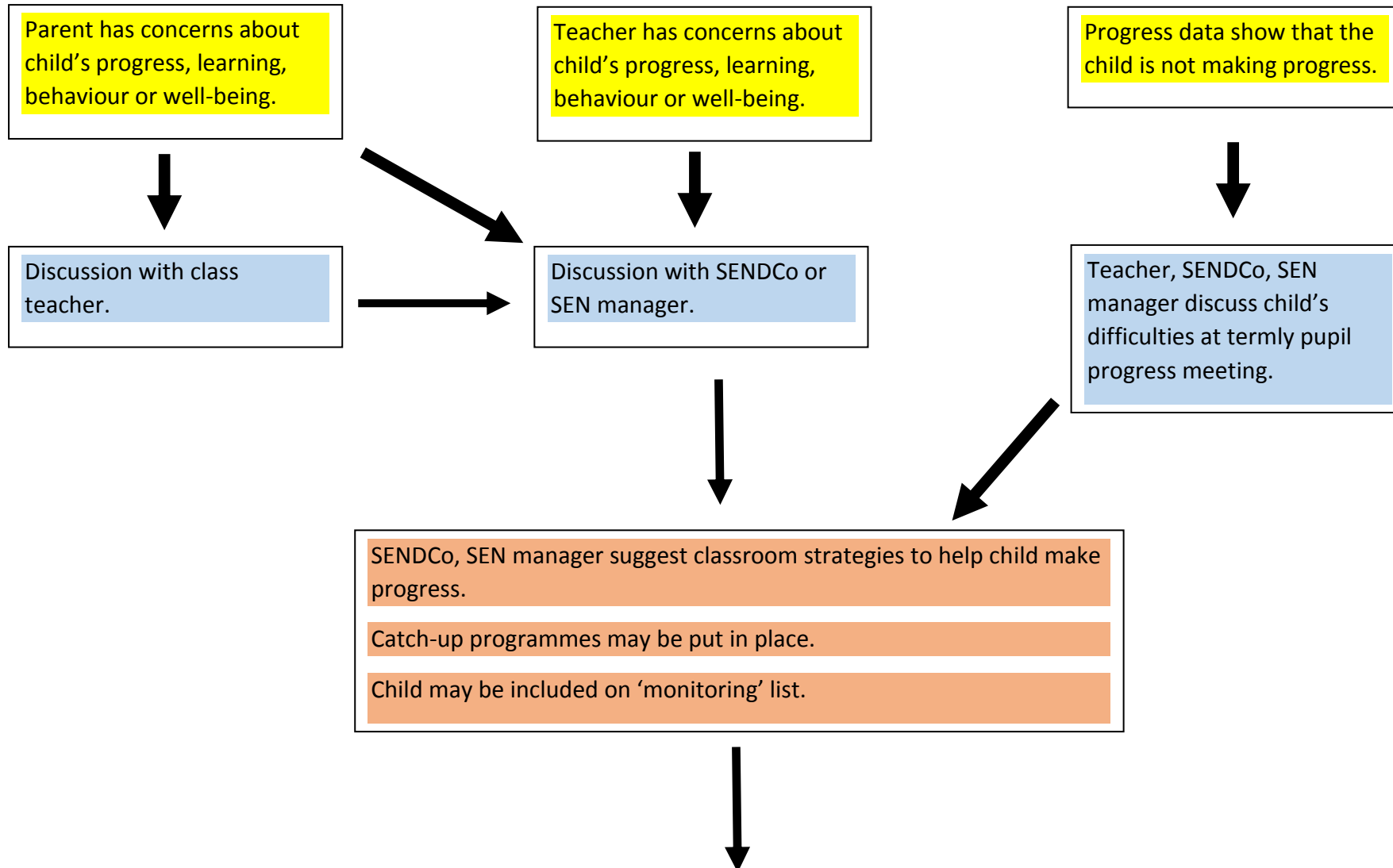


WHAT HAPPENS IF MY CHILD HAS DIFFICULTIES WITH LEARNING?

This diagram shows what happens if parents or teachers have concerns about a child's progress or learning. Parents are encouraged to talk to their child's class teacher or make an appointment to see the SENDCo directly if they have concerns about their child's learning.



Child's progress is reviewed regularly by teachers, SENDCo and SEN manager and discussed with parents.

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Child's progress is good

Child is removed from 'monitoring' list. Progress continues to be monitored in class.

Child is starting to make progress.

Child remains on 'monitoring' list. Progress continues to be monitored by teachers, SENDCo and SEN manager.

Child is still not making progress.

SENDCo consults parents to suggest that child is included on SEN register.
