Curriculum

This term our topic will be 'Angry Earth'; this is a Geography based topic. We will be learning about earthquakes and volcanoes, including exploring these on maps, understanding the different types of volcanoes and looking at the layers of the Earth.

Similarly, in Science, we will be learning about Rocks. In Maths, we will be looking at Multiplication and Division. In English, we will be continuing our non-fiction unit, where we are writing an information text based on The Truth about trolls, then writing a suspense story inspired by Escape from Pompeii.

Reading

Children will read with an adult everyday during Class Reader or Phonics sessions. Their home/school books will be changed whenever the children ask but no earlier than once a week. This allows the children to re-read books at home and develop fluency to become confident readers. They should be encouraged to read a wide range of texts at home. We recommend 10 minutes a night.

Once a week, children will spend time in the library and can choose a library book.
