Flu Immunisation

The School Aged Immunisation Service visited our school on Monday to offer the nasal flu vaccination. If your child is in Reception to Year 6 and missed this opportunity to be vaccinated and you would like your child to receive the vaccine please contact us to book an appointment at one of our community catch up clinics.

Community Library Sheds

Following the success of the mini lending library that we opened during the first lockdown, we have now purchased two small sheds, which we have turned into community lending libraries for children. These will further supplement our own school library collection and will hopefully encourage children to read widely for pleasure.

The shed near the Community entrance has a small collection of books suitable for Early Years (Nursery and Reception) and Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2). The shed near the Key Stage 2 entrance has books suitable for Key Stage 2 (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6). The Rothwell Citizen's Welfare Committee has kindly donated some activity and curriculum support books which will also be stored in the shed.

Please feel free to browse the collections before and after school. We ask that children choose one book at a time please so there is enough for everyone. If children choose one of the donated activity books, these do not need to be returned and can be kept at home.

Any returned books need to be placed in the plastic box stored behind the bottom door of each shed so that they can be quarantined before being added back to the collection. If you have any children's books that you no longer have use for, please put them in the returns box. We will be grateful for any donations.

We would respectfully ask that you continue to observe social distancing with one family group at a time browsing the community library sheds.

Virtual Voucher

If your child is entitled to a virtual voucher, unspent money from last year will be rolled over for you to use this year. You will still get the full amount for this year too (£100 for children in KS1 and £200 for children in KS2). If you are unsure how much money is still available on your virtual voucher from last year and would like to check, please contact the office and they will be happy to tell you. Orange voucher cards will not be issued this year, please advise the school office if you wish to use your voucher for school uniform, residentials, sporting clubs or music lessons.

Penalty Notices for unauthorised absences

The current situation has been reviewed and the local authority will again be using the Penalty Notice system as part of their range of sanctions in dealing with attendance issues.

Whilst they continue to recognise the anxiety that remains for some parents, the national guidance is clear that all children should be attending school except in a few specific circumstances.

Cold Weather

<u>Distribution of Free School Meal Vouchers for October Half-term</u>

As you may be aware, following central Government's decision to not provide Free School Meals for the October half-term period, Northamptonshire County Council decided to distribute vouchers in their place, in an effort to help support our most vulnerable families. Each eligible child was to receive a voucher to the value of £15, that could be used at a number of supermarkets.

The Local Authority are pleased to confirm that the majority of children and young people eligible for FSM in the county are now in receipt of a £15 voucher.

However, vouchers were distributed using contact details for parents that were provided at the time the initial application for FSM was made. In some instances, NCC do not hold contact details for individual children and young people or the contact details were out of date. As such, not all children and young people who are eligible for FSM will have received a voucher.






