## Entrance/Exit Gates

Please can we remind parents to continue to use the established one way system at the gates – entering from either Gate 1 (the Whitehills end gate) or Gate 3 (the Cheaney Court end gate) and leaving via the Gate 2 (the central gate next to the Nursery building) at drop off and collection times. Please also remember that all adults must wear a mask while on site unless they are medically exempt. These gates are then locked during the school day and access is via Gate 2 (the central gate)

## **Polling Station**

Please note that the school **will not be** in use as a Polling Station on Thursday 6th May. School will be open as usual.

## Hot Weather

In preparation for any hot weather - please remember to apply sun cream before school during any sunny weather. Children may wear hats and sunglasses, but please ensure they are clearly named before sending them into school. Although it should be warm sunny weather, we also need all children to have a coat available should it turn wet. Please can all children have a named water bottle in school each day. This bottle is for the children to use



throughout the school day and should only contain water. This is additional to their lunch drink.

## Medical Appointments during School time

If your child needs to attend a medical appointment during the school day, please let the school office know and provide a copy of the letter/appointment card via email prior to the appointment so this can be properly recorded as a medical appointment on your child's records.

## <u>Medicines/creams in school</u>

If your child needs to have medicine or cream to be applied in school, a medical form is required to be completed before this can used. This can be downloaded from the school website or emailed from the school office.

## <u>Sickness and Diarrhoea</u>

Please can we remind parents about the rules regarding sickness and diarrhoea. If your child is suffering with sickness or diarrhoea, they cannot return to school until 48 hours after the last bout. If your child is absent from school due to illness, please ring the school office and leave a message on the absence line everyday of your child's absence.

## **Bicycle helmets**

We have seen a number of children riding to and from school on their bikes without using a helmet. Please can we ask all parents to ensure helmets are worn at all times.

On average half of the road injuries received by cyclists are to the face and the head. Make sure your child always wears a correctly- fitted helmet to protect against head injuries should they fall. It should be worn correctly, which means it:

- is positioned squarely on their head, sitting just above the eyebrows and not tilted back or tipped forwards
- must be a snug fit
- should not stop them seeing clearly or cover their ears
- has its straps securely fastened and not twisted, with only enough room for two fingers between their chin and the strap
