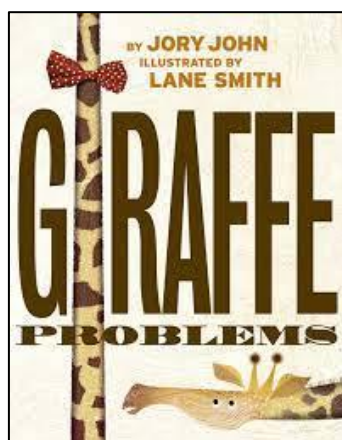
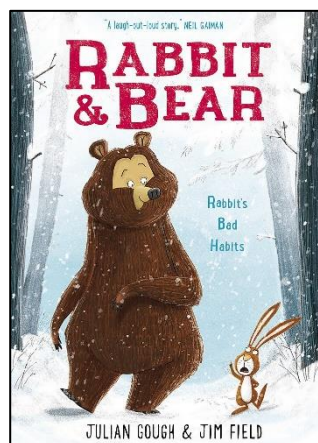


LOATLANDS LOVES READING

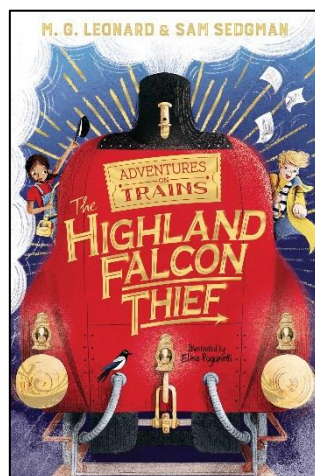
