As we are now in the summer term I appreciate you will not be wanting to spend lots of money on new uniform as things start to fall apart or become a little tight.

Please can I remind you that we do have a selection of nearly new items for sale that might help to see you through to the summer holiday.

Also remember that school uniform doesn't need to have a logo but does need to be school colours. I know local supermarkets sell our school uniform for as little as £1.50.

From September I would really like to push the smartness of the school uniform. I am a real believer that smart children have a smart mind. Over the years I'm sure different items have crept into school and I feel the uniform is not as smart as it could be. I am wanting to share these thoughts now, before you start purchasing items over the summer, so that we are ready in September to return with smartness.

From September we will continue to ask children to come to school dressed for PE. However, this will be tightened up to being a PLAIN black bottom, (shorts, cycling shorts, leggings, tracksuit bottoms) a red t-shirt (logo or not) a school jumper / cardigan and a pair of sporting trainers. (Fashion trainers are not ideal as the children need to support their ankles)

Finally, a reminder around the extras.

Hair, must be tied up once it is long enough to do so with a bobble and no large bows. Children are prone to nits and although we welcome everyone into our school we would rather keep these away.

Jewellery, must only be a small stud earring and children in Year 3 upwards can wear a watch (no camera watches for safeguarding reasons).

Nail varnish and tattoos should be for school holidays ONLY.
